- “**In the Footsteps of the Savior**” by Max Lucado
 - **When:** Monday nights starting on February 27th starting at 6:30 p.m.
 - **Where:** This is a home study group at Bill & Francie Krills.
 - **Study Description:** “In this 6 session study, you travel with Max Lucado through Capernaum, Galilee, Bethany, Jerusalem, and more. As Max weaves together insights from his own travels to Israel with teaching from his bestselling books, he will guide you to walk where Jesus walked and ponder the promises he made.
- “**The Lord’s Prayer: *The Meaning and Power of the Prayer Jesus Taught Us***” by Adam Hamilton

Huddles:

- Huddles are our primary vehicle for making disciples who make disciples. Huddles incorporate both invitation and challenge.
